If you are looking to join a cycling club for the first time please follow the process below.

If you are looking to join and are currently, or have been registered with another club in the last 5 years, you can easily arrange a clearance from your current/previous club. Complete the top section of the Clearance form (<http://www.qld.cycling.org.au/site/cycling/qld/downloads/Resources/Application%20for%20Clearance.doc.pdf>) and have the secretary of the current/previous club complete and sign the bottom section, and then submit this to us with your new application forms (WRCC and CA).

WRCC MEMBER APPLICATIONS: (the paperwork)

First step is to complete the required forms as detailed below. Once forwarded to the club (treasurer) either by mail or email, payment will need to be made into the club account.

Thereafter the application will be put forward at the next club meeting (usually 3rd Monday of each month). It is important that you attend the meeting, particularly if you are not known to the current club membership or committee members. It is also recommended that you have participated in a few club rides so that you have had the opportunity to meet club members and experience some of the rides and club culture.

After approval of the application the paperwork will be prepared for submission to Cycling Qld/Cycling Aus. All membership is accepted via a registered Cycling Club (racing and recreational). WRCC will forward the documentation to Cycling Queensland who processes the membership, - then Cycling Australia prints and posts the Membership Card with the License Number and a handbook to the member. This process takes about two weeks from the date the club sends the membership to Cycling Queensland. (New Cards are forwarded annually upon Membership Renewal.)

IF YOU INTEND TO RACE BEFORE YOUR NEW LICENCE ARRIVES - CONSIDER ALSO THAT YOU WILL NEED TO OBTAIN THE RECEIPT AND HAVE THE CLUB TREASURER STAMP YOUR COPY OF THE FORM.

(In the interim - you may then present this as proof of Membership)

NB. As a Recreational (Participation or Social Member), you are still entitled to upgrade to a full Competitive Membership/License in the future if you so desire.
